I have some exciting news to share about our Hudson Branch Campus Middle College.

Our first group of middle college seniors will walk at graduation on Sunday, May 31. Here is the data about these 3 young ladies:

- One student will walk with a total of 26 college credits, she is on-pace to get an associates degree by next spring.
- A second student will walk with a total of 22 college credits, she is also considering Spring courses in 2020, to enable her to achieve an associates degree by next spring.
- Our third student will walk with 19 college credits. She might take some Spring courses to get her towards a goal of first year of college complete.

I share this information because these students are now 1 year ahead of their cohorts that did not take advantage of this incredible opportunity. Not only are they 1 year ahead in their college classes, they also do not have any student debt. Middle College courses and textbooks are covered by the Hudson Branch Campus Middle College.
