

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Q1: How is the curriculum delivered in the virtual academy?**

A1: Grades 6-12 use Edgenuity (formerly E2020). Grades K-5 will use Edmentum. This format is NOT distance learning where Hudson teachers instruct online. These are recorded instructors providing Michigan approved instruction.

### **Q2: Is there a lab provided on campus for grades 7-12?**

A2: Yes there will be a lab at CSI. The lab will be open from 7:30 AM-7 PM Monday-Friday. This is NOT a walk-in lab. You must sign-up with Mr. Reed to get access to the lab. Do not expect to be able to stay in the lab for the entire day as others will want to access the lab as well. 2.5 hours is a typical lab stay.

### **Q3: Is there a lab provided on campus for grades K-6?**

A3: Yes there will be a lab at CSI. The lab will be open from 7:30 AM-7 PM Monday-Friday. This is NOT a walk-in lab. You must sign-up with the elementary instructor to get access to the lab. Lab times will typically be 2-3 hours. This is NOT a classroom. Parents cannot drop students off for the day. It is recommended that they stay for the lab time if possible.

### **Q4: Will breakfast or lunch be provided at CSI**

A4: No

### **Q5: Will I be provided with a laptop to do my work?**

A5: All students in grades K-12 will be provided with an I-Pad or ChromeBook this fall.

### **Q6: Can my student still participate in extracurricular activities such as sports?**

A6: Yes, as long as the student meets the eligibility requirements.

### **Q7: What if my student wanted to switch to the virtual school in the middle of the semester?**

A7: They can, but would be required to complete the ENTIRE course by the end of the semester to receive credit.

### **Q8: Will transportation be provided to the labs for my student?**

A8: Only virtual academy students who are partial virtual students will have the opportunity to use the school provided transportation. All others must transport themselves or have parent/guardian transport them.

### **Q9: How much work should my student do daily?**

A9: All classes are paced to so students and parents can see daily if they are on track to finish on time or not. Students can work at their own pace but must be complete by the end of the semester.

### **Q10: Will my student have a teacher or academic coach?**

A10: All students will be assigned an academic coach that will check in with them regularly.

### **Q11: How do I follow my child's progress?**

A11: Parents will get weekly updates by email, text or phone call with student progress.

### **Q12: If my student switches to the virtual academy are they a part of a different school?**

A12: No. Your student is just receiving curriculum differently. They are still a Hudson student.

### **Q13: If the whole district is forced back into distance learning does my student stay in the virtual academy?**

A13: Yes

### **Q14: Does my student have to wear a mask in the virtual lab?**

A14: Yes
